The museum explains the entire history of the phonograph. On display is the first manual cylindrical record player and 25 other record players representing the technological advancements made during the past 100 years.

The record bank is where the museum stores all its records in a climate-controlled room that is protected from natural disasters. All records can be tracked by computer.
